

Certificate in Landscape Design

The Certificate in Landscape Design provides students with the knowledge and skills necessary for employment as designers within the Landscape Design/Build industry. Coursework applies topics covered in lecture format directly to hands-on design and landscape project management skills utilized within the landscape industry. This includes basic plant growth requirements, a thorough understanding of preexisting project site conditions, basic landscape design practices and principles, design and implementation requirements for specific and complex landscape systems, a thorough knowledge in the use of prevalent design and graphic software applications, and improved methods to convey and market design concepts to potential landscape clients.
