

Certificate in Jazz Studies

Undergraduate Music and Music Education Majors (BM, BA Music) may earn a Certificate in Jazz Studies by completing this core of courses in jazz. Approval for admission into the Certificate program must be received from the Director of Jazz Studies, Dr. Sam Griffith, GriffithSv@missouri.edu.

Requirements

A certificate consists of at least 12 credits; at least 12 credits must be taken in MU course work. Students must meet the minimum GPA requirements for a certificate, which in no case can be lower than 2.0. In addition, a student cannot receive a grade lower than a C- in any course applied towards a certificate in the College.
