

Graduate Certificate in Public Policy

The graduate certificate in public policy offers students a strong foundation in the skills necessary to work effectively in the policy environment. Students will learn theories of the policy process, quantitative and qualitative research methods to analyze policy, and program evaluation. Students also have the opportunity to gain expertise in specific policy areas including education policy, environmental policy, health policy, social policy, and regional development policy.

Requirements

Students must complete 12 credit hours to receive the certificate.

Students do not need to be enrolled in a graduate degree program at MU to participate in the program. Some prerequisite courses may be necessary for students without prior coursework in statistics. The graduate certificate in public policy can be completed 100% online.
