## Thesis/Non-Thesis Requirements

In addition to 33 hours of coursework, to complete a Master of Education (MEd), students must write a reflective capstone paper, drawing on knowledge gained throughout the program.

## Admissions

Applicants are required to meet two sets of minimum qualifications for admission: the requirements of the MEd in Educational Leadership and Policy Analysis (<https://gradschool.missouri.edu/degrecategory/educational-leadership-policy-analysis/>) and the minimum requirements of the Graduate School (<https://gradschool.missouri.edu/admissions/eligibility-process/>).
