

## EdSp in Learning Technologies and Design

## **Degree Requirements**

The EdSp in Learning Technologies and Design requires students to select an emphasis area from the two options offered: Technology in Schools (http://catalog.missouri.edu/collegeofeducation/learningtechnologiesdesign/edsp-learning-technologies-design-emphasis-technology-schools/), and Online Education (http://catalog.missouri.edu/collegeofeducation/learningtechnologiesdesign/edsp-learning-technologies-design-emphasis-online-education/). While general degree requirements information is below, students should refer to the emphasis page for detailed requirements.

The EdSp consists of 30 graduate credit hours, with a minimum of 15 at the 9000 level or above. The curriculums allow you to customize your course work by focusing on technology design and development or technology implementation.
