

# Certificate in Ethical Theory and Practice

## Requirements

Students are required to complete 12 credits in courses offered by the Department of Philosophy in the area of ethical theory and practice.

A certificate consists of at least 12 credits; at least 12 credits must be taken in MU course work. Students must meet the minimum GPA requirements for a certificate, which in no case can be lower than 2.0. In addition, a student cannot receive a grade lower than a C- in any course applied towards a certificate in the College.
