

# BES in Educational Studies with Emphasis in Educational Leadership

## Degree Program Description

The Educational Leadership emphasis area is designed for undergraduate learners who are interested in becoming educational and community leaders in the areas of non-profit, global, higher education and social justice. The courses will provide a foundation in educational theory, research, and practice that will help engage students in settings where they can influence change (e.g., schools, international contexts, student affairs, churches, sports, non-profits, private organizations).

## Major Program Requirements

The BES in Educational Studies with Emphasis in Educational Leadership requires students to complete 120 credit hours. Students are required to complete all University general education (<https://catalog.missouri.edu/academicdegree/requirements/generaleducationrequirements/>), and University graduation requirements (<https://catalog.missouri.edu/academicdegree/requirements/universityrequirements/>), in addition to at least 24 credit hours of educational core courses and 24 credit hours of emphasis area course requirements.

Students must earn no less than a 2.00 GPA, as defined by the GPA of Record. For the BES degree in CEHD, students must earn a C- or higher in all CEHD coursework taken to meet program requirements. Additionally, a grade of C- or higher is required for any course taken to fulfill either the core or the concentration area of the program. Students must meet the residence requirements of MU and shall have a professional practicum. The student must be recommended for the degree by the faculty of the College of Education and Human Development. At 60 credit hours of completed coursework, students will be required to complete a Graduation Plan that will serve as a preliminary graduation check. All courses are offered with online options.
