

Certificate in Web and Mobile Applications Development

Students pursuing the Undergraduate Certificate in Web and Mobile Applications Development will experience the complete flow from environment configuration, design, implementation, debugging, and deployment of web and mobile applications, and gain a foundation for in-demand skills and knowledge of the latest technologies used in industry to build web and mobile applications. They will be employable as mobile/web app developers, product managers, and project managers with experience working in multiple platforms that are in high demand.
