

Certificate in Interprofessional Practice

This certificate is relevant for students pursuing medicine, physician assistant studies, nursing, physical therapy, occupational therapy, and speech, language, and hearing sciences, and other related fields.

Requirements

Requires 13 credit hours for completion, consisting of 10 credit hours of required coursework and one 3 credit elective selected from an approved list. The curriculum is designed to provide students with foundational knowledge and practical skills in interprofessional collaboration, ethics, health literacy, communication, and working with special populations.
