

Health Science Electives

Students who are persuing a undergraduate degree in Health Science must take 18 hours of electives, 9 hours must be 3000/4000-level courses. Transfer courses taken at the freshman/sophomore level and accepted as equivalent to a 3000/4000 level course at MU will not count towards the 9 hour upper level Health Science Elective requirement. Hours taken for electives cannot also count towards emphasis area requirements, however, courses not used towards the emphasis requirement can be used as elective hours as noted in the course list depending on the emphasis area.

The following elective courses count towards all emphasis areas and options unless otherwise notated.
